#### Toy Afternoon

We have been running Toy Afternoon very successfully for a couple of years now. It is great to see children enjoying themselves together having worked hard throughout the term to make good behaviour choices. I believe, however, that Toy Afternoon has moved away from its original intentions with some of the toy choices that have started to creep in.

Toy Afternoon is all about playing together, with friends, sharing, taking turns and getting on. For this reason I am tightening up again on what type of toy is appropriate to bring.

Appropriate toys - board games, construction toys, card games, dolls and teddies (particularly popular in KS1). Anything that can be played by more than one person at the same time.

**Inappropriate toys** - Ipads/tablets, guns or toy weapons of any sort, action figures (these tend to end up being used for fighting games). Noisy electronic games with no volume control.

I have spoken to the children in assembly about this so they understand the decisions made. I have said that if they are in any doubt about whether a toy is allowed they should ask their teacher.

With this half term being so short our next toy afternoon is in two weeks! I look forward to seeing your child there!
