
As usual, the newsletter is a really good source of current information but don't forget the new school website - this should always be the first place that you should look.

Vaccinations at School

The whole school (EYFS to Y6) are to receive this vaccination on Friday 22nd November 2019. Letters and an accompanying leaflet will be given out on Friday 8th November 2019 so please look out for them coming home with your child.

Height and Weight -Year 6

On Tuesday 12th November 2019 the School Nurse Service will be coming into school to measure the height and weight of Y6 children as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). The NCMP provides information to help build an understanding of how children are growing, so that the best possible advice and support can be provided for them and their families.

A letter has been sent home via Y6 children. This includes a letter to opt out of the NCMP if you wish. Please note that school will be providing the nurse with the following information:

- Name
- Address
- Gender
- Date of birth



Jewellery and Step-Counters

Our current statement on jewellery in school states that children should only be wearing a simple watch and stud earrings. From listening to parents' and pupils' opinions on this I have had a change of heart. I have also considered the NHS promotion 'Change for Life' and in the interest of our pupils wellbeing I am making a change to our jewellery policy.

Children may wear

- \checkmark A device that only tells the time.
- \checkmark A device that only counts steps.
- \checkmark A device that tells the time and counts steps.

Devices that connect to the internet are NOT allowed in school.



If the device should become a distraction during learning then it will be removed from the child and kept safely at the office for an adult to collect.
