Report From Previous Year

Constitution

Stephanie has investigated this and has discovered that we can adopt the Parentkind template. This must be submitted 90 days prior to the AGM so this will be done before next year's meeting.

Financial Update:

£2,500 was given to the school by The Friends which paid for an Atlas for each key stage, and new tuned percussion instruments which have been a huge success.

Scary Hair Day raised £236.07 (up from £189 last year)

We want to inform parents of our financial spending as a social media post (send to Nicky Harvey) and via the school website: Zellah

General Business:

- 5p collections to restart at some point after Christmas. We will also consider an alternative such as filling raisin boxes with money at home. However we need to be mindful about sending anything home due to limitations because of covid-19.
- Clothing bank will be open for parents to drop off donations at all times. This will be
 advertised on Facebook by Stacey, and a laminated poster will be displayed by
 Eleanor. This will be reviewed in the new year when the clothing recycling
 companies are open again and we can look for the best possible deal.

• <u>Christmas</u>

We are finalising arrangements for a virtual personalised Christmas performance which the Friends will fund. The cost is £175. Zellah

The idea of the children performing Christmas songs for a DVD for parents is unfortunately not allowed to go ahead due to Covid-19 restrictions.

We agreed that the idea of a virtual Santa visit was unnecessary because of the aforementioned virtual personalised performance.

All reminders have been sent out to parents regarding the children's christmas card designs. Although we can't really compare this to other years due to the unusual circumstances of 2020, it will be reviewed in the new year to ascertain how much money was raised, and if parents found this system simpler/better than previous years. We will maybe do a parent survey about this and other fundraisers.

We discussed Eco Friendly Christmas Crackers or a gift for the children to take home for example decorate your own tree decorations. However Becca raised concerns over lack of space during Christmas dinner this year because dinner will be in the classrooms. Zellah to consider further; maybe something can be sent home prior to Christmas dinner day.

Within school it has already been arranged for the children in each class to open an advent door each day, with a different treat behind each door (please don't tell your children about this yet!) Treats include things like movie and popcorn on Thursday 17th December. Two Friends volunteers will be needed to bag up popcorn and source kernels. Stacey has volunteered but we need one more person.

A Christmas trail was suggested by Zellah but it was decided it's too much work this time and we might do something along those lines for Halloween 2021.

• <u>Toy Afternoon</u>

This was a success but we still need more toys. Becca has sent a wish list for each year group to Zellah. Is it possible to provide 1 x shop bought game per class? Becca suggested maybe they could be wrapped and given as a gift from the "Friends". Zellah has sent wrapping paper in to school, and Becca confirmed that the teachers can wrap the gift for their class. We will ask parents again for donations from next week onwards. We will specify which games the children have asked for. We have spent £57 on games and toys so far.

- Online banking has been set up for the Friends bank account. However we need a second person to activate it. Barbara Hale has volunteered.
- Policy Requirements Review
