

Dear Families,

The Friends of Dothill School are delighted to invite you to our forthcoming **Summer Fair Friday 8th July 2:30pm until 4pm.** On the day parents/careers are allowed to collect their children from their classroom from 2:30pm. At the fair each class will run an activity stall, with games such as hoopla, hook a duck, lucky lolly, beat the goalie, splat the rat, tin can alley, play your cards right,. All the school activities/stalls will be paid for using a token system, whereby families buy tokens for 50p from the 'bank' to make playing/buying a quicker process at each stall. The friends will be running stalls like booze or bust and toy tombola. Please note that some stalls are 2 or more tokens a go. **Please bring cash** as there are no card facilities. We are aware not all families are able to collect earlier, so will hold back half the prizes until after 3:15pm.

On the day of the fair each child will be given a slip which includes:

- a free fill of your bottle (water/squash)
- a free tattoo

There is a **Muffi Day** on **Friday 1st July**, where the children are invited to come to school in non-uniform. We ask that the children bring in a donation for the fair of either:

- a gift voucher

Please can all donations be handed in at the classroom door on arrival that morning. The money collected will be used to purchase prizes. In addition, we will also run our free school uniform stall, where families are welcome to help themselves to uniform ready for the forthcoming school year & Ricky King Cone the Ice Cream man will be there too.

In order for the school fairs to run we require help off parents/carers. We are grateful for any help, as these events cannot take place without your support. In addition to help on the day we require help with organising - ticketing up etc on the morning of mufti donations. If you can help (even just for a little while) please compete the slip at the bottom of this letter and return to us by Thursday 30th June.

We hope it is going to be a lovely day and you will all have a great time. Funds raised on the day will be split between helping the school buy new gymnastics equipment to enhance their PE offer and further experiences, opportunities, trips and resources.
